## **Background note**

The Country Gentleman was a farmers' magazine published from 1831 to 1955. The articles frequently addressed the business side of farming and offered tips on how to raise produce and livestock. Short stories were featured as well. By the last year of its publication, it was the second most popular agricultural magazine in the United States.

## **Scope and Contents**

This small collection contains seven issues of The Country Gentlemen magazine beginning with the November 1917 issue, and ending with the June 1919 issue. All contain Norman Rockwell covers and are wonderful examples of some of his earlier works.
