The Museum



The Main Lobby welcomes your guests and begins the experience at Norman Rockwell Museum. This 44' x 24' space is the ideal location for cocktails and hors d'oeuvres.

The Galleries - During events, the Museum's ten galleries are open for guests to enjoy the art of Norman Rockwell and other American illustrators. Tour guides are available for private gallery talks. Food and drink are not permitted in the galleries.

The Stockbridge Room provides an "art-filled" experience for any event. With 1075 sq. ft. of space, this lovely gallery can seat up to 75 guests for dinner.

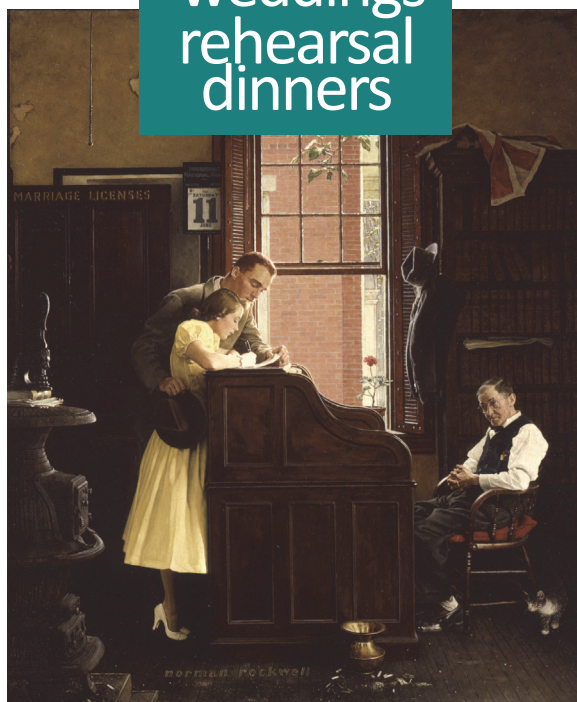

The Terrace offers a serene, outdoor setting with picturesque views of Rockwell's Studio, apple trees, fields and hills. This 2400 sq. ft. stone terrace is tented from May through October; the perfect place for receptions for up to 250 guests or dinners for 175.

Linwood House

Built in 1859, this historic Berkshire "Cottage" is located on the Museum grounds, sitting majestically on the hill overlooking Rockwell's Studio and the Housatonic River. Decorated with period antiques, consider Linwood House for entertaining up to 75 guests. Bridal parties may reserve the house for dressing, photo sessions and it is an exquisite backdrop for a ceremony.

The Museum Campus encompasses 36 park-like acres and includes Rockwell's Stockbridge studio, the historic Linwood House, and outdoor sculptures by Peter Rockwell along meandering walking trails. Enjoy panoramic views of the Berkshire hills and Housatonic River. Open lawns provide ample space for tent placements for larger parties.
