



The auction package will be awarded to the highest bidder at the close of the auction on May 1, 2012, at 5:00 p.m. The law of the State of Massachusetts shall govern with respect to all auction sales. Once a bid is placed, it cannot be retracted. All bids are final and cannot be removed; no cancellations or refunds permitted.
